#### **AGM**

A big thank you to everyone who was able to attend the AGM on 11<sup>th</sup> February. 44 members attended and following the meeting were treated to musical entertainment provided by Mr. Richard Churchley.

## Membership

During the AGM opnocs new membership scheme was introduced. Membership would be £2 per annum and entitle those who signed up to discounts on trips, the quarterly newsletter and other relevant information. To date 74 people have registered as a member of opnocs.

### **Funding**

Funding from Birmingham Council has been extended until the end of June. This is because of a delay in assessing applications from consortia to deliver Universal Prevention Services in Birmingham.

Opnocs is part of a consortium led by Birmingham Multi Care.

#### **Ageing Better update**

Opnocs is a partner of the Sparkbrook Ageing Better Hub. The bid, led by Narthax was submitted on 8<sup>th</sup> April. Narthax is based at St. Johns Church, Sparkhill.

£250,000 will be available to provide activities and services in Sparkbrook. A further £400,000 will be made available further consultation with older people and the formulation of an Action Plan.

As opnocs is based in Sparkbrook we should be able to apply for pockets of money to provide activities for our members.

#### **Grants**

Opnocs has received a grant of £1,850 from Comic Relief Local Communities. This will allow opnocs to continue the

provision of computer classes for older people. More information to follow. Also, Opnocs has just received notification of a successful bid for £900 from Sport Relief Community Cash. The grant will be used to provided mini trips for less mobile members. In the past we have taken members for afternoon tea at various local venues.
